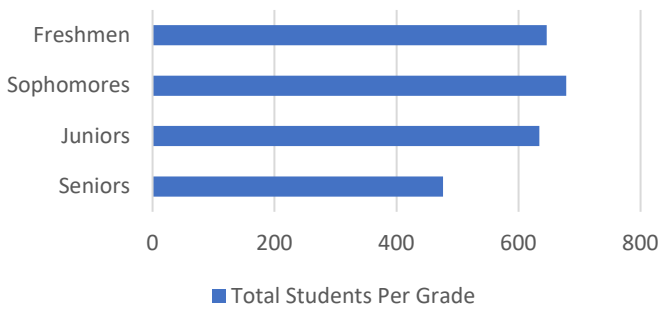

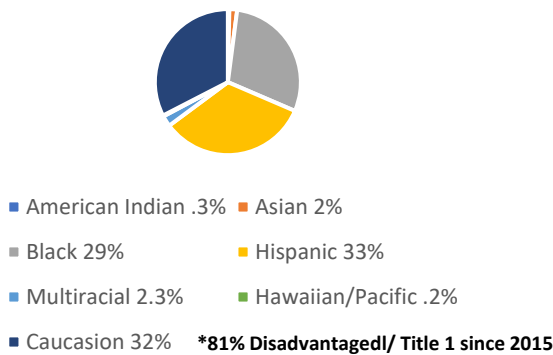
2022-2023 Enrollment

Racial Diversity

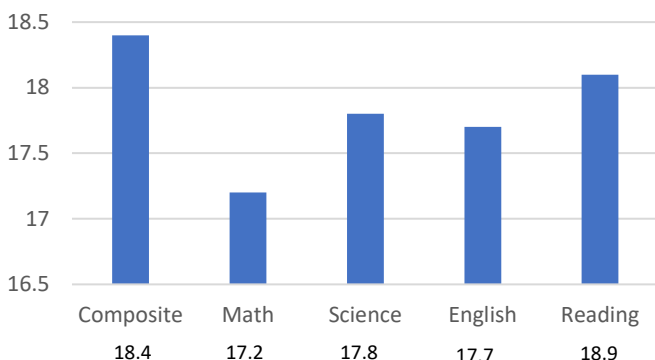

Cambridge/AICE Course Offerings

Admission to the WHHS Cambridge/AICE Program, also known as GCE A Levels, is available to incoming freshmen by application only. Acceptance is contingent upon achieving the 85th percentile on the SAT 10 standardized exam. The Cambridge/AICE Program is an international program from the University of Cambridge in England. The AICE Diploma is a distinguished award requiring passing scores on seven college level exams. These courses are the most rigorous available to our students at Winter Haven High School.
